### Timesheet Deadline

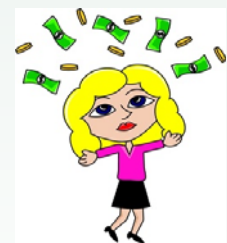

## Berry & Apple Bake

- 300ml thickened cream
- 175g unsalted butter
- 3 eggs
- 2 cups plain flour
- 1 cup caster sugar
- 3 granny smith apples
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 2 tbs lemon juice
- 300g frozen mixed berries
- Icing sugar to dust
- Strawberry jam to serve



### Method

1. Preheat oven to 180°C. Grease and flour a 32 x 22cm baking dish. Bring cream and butter to just below boiling point in a pan over medium heat. Cool slightly.
2. Beat eggs with sugar until thick and pale. Slowly beat in cream mixture. Sift in fl our, then fold to combine with a metal spoon. Stir in vanilla, apples and berries, then pour into pan. Bake for 40 minutes or until golden and a skewer inserted in centre comes out clean.
3. Serve with icing sugar, jam and extra cream.
