## Building high performing teams in a dynamic environment

Conventional leaders and leadership of the past are insufficient to meet the demands of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century. As we enter the new millennium, our world is characterised by unprecedented complexity, paradox and unpredictability. Change is rapid and relentless. Today’s leaders face demands unlike any ever before faced. Standard leadership approaches that have served us well throughout much of history are quickly becoming liabilities. Conventional wisdom regarding leadership and many of its habits must be unlearned. Our synthesis of the emerging views of leadership suggests that the Business Olympian leader is personally more adaptive and resilient, broader in perspective, and more proactive than his or her predecessors. Importantly, they are also more effective in cultivating these habits and qualities in others. This workshop will explore these concepts and challenge your current thinking and approach. The goal here is to push yourself beyond your current limit.

### Content Overview

The difference between professionals & the reason why some are considered standouts or super stars is one simple fact.

*They are able to produce these skills consistently under pressure!*

This incredibly practical session highlights how we create a high performing team. In doing so, it will also highlight the flaws and mistakes we tend to make – thus gaining insight. The content is grounded in a team work model which was designed to help facilitate high performing teams perform consistently, be more adaptive and develop resilience in all environments. Within the workshop we explore the process of creating accountability and how to develop a sense of “team” whereby the team is as accountable to the outcome as is the leader. The afternoon session explores our ability to perform under pressure and the strategies champions utilise to maintain their focus. The final session provides the participant with templates

on identifying the capability of their team and how well it is matched to the complexity of the tasks required of them.
