CHOCOLATE CARAMEL BROWNIE HEARTS

Serves 12



Indulge in some Valentine's Day romance with these sweet treats sure to melt hearts.

Ingredients

150g butter chopped
180g dark chocolate chopped
1/2 cup caster sugar
2 eggs, lightly beaten
1 1/4 cups plain flour
2 tbsp cocoa powder
220g block caramello chocolate, frozen chopped

Method

Preheat oven to 180°C/160°C fan-forced.
Grease a 18cm x 28cm rectangular slice pan. Line base and sides with baking paper, allowing a 2cm overhang a long ends.
Place butter and dark chocolate in a medium saucepan over medium heat. Cook, stirring for 3 to 5 minutes or until smooth. Remove from heat. Stir in sugar. Set aside for 5 minutes.
Whisk eggs into chocolate mixture until combined. Add sifted flour and cocoa. Whisk to combine. Fold in caramello chocolate. Spread mixture into prepared pan. Bake for 20 minutes or until top is firm to touch. Set aside to cool completely.
Using a 5cm heart-shaped cutter, cut brownie shapes. Serve dusted with cocoa powder.
