5 Minute Chocolate Mug Cake



Ingredients

- 4 tbsp SR flour 3 tbsp oil
- 4 tbsp sugar 3 tbsp chocolate chips (optional)
- 2 tbsp cocoa a small splash of vanilla extract
- 1 egg 1 large coffee mug
- 3 tbsp milk

Method

Add dry ingredients to mug, and mix well. Add the egg and mix thoroughly. Pour in the milk and oil and mix well. Add the chocolate chips (if using) and vanilla extract, and mix again.



Put your mug in the microwave and cook for 3 minutes at 1000 watts (high). The cake will rise over the top of the mug, but don't be alarmed! Allow to cool a little, and tip out onto a plate if desired.

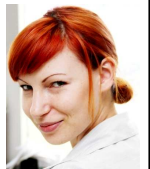


The cake is big enough to serve 2!

Giovanni's Trattoria Parramatta is a humble and traditional Italian experience. Nestled between Phillip and Church Street, Chef Giovanni offers a variety of dishes from traditionally prepared pizzas with quality toppings from \$12.90 to a variety of pastas and mains. I am a fan of the **Spaghetti alla Chitarra**— al dente cooked pasta tossed with olive oil, garlic, chilli, herbs, white wine, king prawns and bruschetta salsa for \$17.90. Though when I'm feeling like a hearty meal I tend to swing towards the **Chicken Boscaiola**—chicken breast slices simmered in white wine, olive oil and herbs, then cooked in a fresh mushroom and ham cream butter sauce for \$19.90

Giovanni has been preparing meals for the likes of Demi Moore and stars alike and I can tell you that I always feel like I get that special treatment when I eat here. The service is fantastic but the food is what keeps me coming back.
