## Beef and Bean Pies

Makes 12

Delicious little pies in crisp bread cases—topped with melted cheese. Great for a Sunday night tea!



### Ingredients

15 Slices of White Toast Bread  
75g butter, melted  
1 small onion, peeled, finely dices,  
250g lean beef mince  
420g Baked Beans in Tomato sauce  
1 tbsp chopped fresh thyme  
1/4—1/2 cup grated tasty cheese

### Instructions

1. Trim the crusts from the bread slices and flatten each with a rolling pin. Cut 12 slices into 10cm diameter rounds. Brush one side lightly with melted butter and place into a 12 cup muffin tin.
2. Bake at 180 degrees Celsius for 15-18 minutes, or until crisp and golden
3. Panfry the onion and beef mince in a dash of oil, until the mince is browned and onion softened. Stir in the baked beans and thyme and heat through.
4. Spoon equal amounts of mixture into the bread cases. Cut remaining bread slices into small triangles and brush with melted butter. Place 2 overlapping triangles on top of each pie and sprinkle with a little grated cheese.
5. Cook for a further 10-12 minutes or until the tops are crisp and golden.
