## Banana Weet-Bix Choc-Chip Muffins

Makes 12



A quick and easy recipe to enjoy as a snack any time of the day.

### Ingredients

3 ripe bananas	4 Weet-Bix
3/4 cup milk	2 eggs
4 tbs margarine	2 tbs brown sugar
1 1/2 cups self-raising flour, sifted	
1 cup chocolate chips	

### Method

Preheat oven to 180°C

Grease a 12-hole muffin pan. Meanwhile, beat together the eggs and margarine, then add to the banana mixture. Combine flour and sugar in a large bowl and add wet ingredients and choc chips.

Stir until just combined, then spoon into muffin pan and bake for 25 minutes until a skewer inserted into the centre comes out clean.

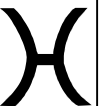
