Recipe:

**Peach and Cream
Cheese Slice**

Serves 6-8

Are you looking for a quick, easy and delicious dessert? Look no further than this Peach and Cream Cheese Slice. Pop it in the oven, put your feet up, and enjoy!



Ingredients

100g softened butter
3/4 cup sugar
2 eggs lightly beaten
1 1/2 cups self raising flour
1/2 cup desiccated coconut
1/4 cup milk

Topping

1x 815g can peach slices, well drained
250g cream cheese, softened
1/4 cup sugar
1 egg

Instructions

1. Put the butter, sugar, eggs, flour, coconut, milk into a food processor and process until blended.
2. Spread into a greased and lined 24 x 30cm slice tin.
3. Arrange the peach slices in even rows on top.
4. Blend the cream cheese, sugar and egg together in the food processor and pour over the top.
5. Bake at 190 degrees celcius for 20-25min, or until golden and well risen.

Serve with cream, mascarpone or ice-cream.
