Mexican Pizza

Serves 4-6

With just a few simple ingredients you can turn the humble pizza into a memorable Mexican mouthful.



Ingredients

425g can Heinz Big Eat Chilli Con Carne
2 x 22 cm pizza bases
150g salami diced
1/2 cup stuffed green olives, chopped (optional)
200g feta crumbled or whole mozzarella, sliced

Topping:

1 avocado, peeled, stoned and chopped
2 spring onions, sliced
2 tbsp fresh coriander or parsley
1 lime, freshly squeezed

Instructions

1. Divide the can of Heinz Spicy Chilli beans evenly between the two pizza bases, sprinkle with diced salami and stuffed green olives. Place the slices of feta or mozzarella on top.
2. Cook the pizzas at 220 degrees Celsius for 7-8 minutes or until golden and hot.
3. Scatter over the avocado, spring onions, coriander and squeeze over the lime juice.

Serve immediately.

Sydney Royal Easter Show April 5th—18th



The Sydney Royal Easter Show is the **largest annual event staged in Australia**, attracting on average around one million Showgoers each year. Sydney Showground, Sydney Olympic Park is transformed to play host to a festival that is unique to Australia and its diverse cultural and rural heritage. The Show runs for **14 days over the Easter period** and is a pinnacle event enjoyed by Australians of all ages.

Essential Information

Transport:

The best way to get to the show is by train. Olympic Park Station is located right next door to the Sydney Showground. A dedicated train service will operate between Olympic Park Station and Lidcombe Station on weekdays during the Show, where customers can change for connecting services. Direct services to Olympic Park Station will operate from Central Station throughout the Show. Additional direct services from Blacktown Station to Olympic Park Station, stopping at Lidcombe will operate on the Easter long weekend (including Easter Monday) and second weekend of the Show.
