Potato Rosti

Serves 4

For Potato Cakes with a difference!
Made with mustard, fresh herbs,
salad cream and mozzarella
cheese.



Ingredients

1/2 cup salad cream
1 cup shredded mozzarella cheese
2 tbsp flour
1/2 cup fresh herbs (sweet basil, chives) finely chopped
3 cups potato, finely grated and peeled
Red onions
Roma tomatoes, halved (slow roasted)
Spinach or rocket leaves
2 1/2 cups sweet potato, finely grated and peeled
Vegetable oil, for frying
1 tbsp wholeseed mustard

Instructions

1. Peel and grate the potatoes. Squeeze as much moisture as you can from the grated potatoes and place in a bowl.
2. Add the mozzarella, salad cream, mustard, flour and herbs in a large bowl. Mix well.
3. Heat oil in a large frying pan and cook 1/4 cup batches of the potato mixture until golden on both sides. Drain on absorbent paper. This is best done in two batches.
4. To serve, place one rosti on each plate, top with 1/2 quantity of green leaves, tomatoes, avocado slices and onions. Repeat and top with a third rosti. Garnish with a little extra salad cream and fresh herbs.
