## Bean Samosas

Makes 15-20

The zing of Baked Beans in Sweet Chilli make these Samosas different to any you've tried before.



### Ingredients

1 tbsp vegetable oil	1 medium potato, diced
1 medium onion, diced	1 tsp ground cumin
1 green capsicum, diced	1 tsp curry powder
1 carrot, diced	1 tsp ground coriander
1 celery stalk, diced	1/2—1/3 cup water
1 packet puff pastry sheets	Vegetable oil, for frying
Salt and Pepper to taste	
1 x 420g can Baked Beans in Sweet Chilli, drained	

### Instructions

1. Heat oil in a large pan and cook the onion, capsicum, carrot and celery until tender. Add Baked Beans and potato. Cook for a further 2 mins.
2. Add spices, stir thoroughly and add water. Reduce the heat to low and simmer gently until the vegetables are tender. Remove from heat, cool.
3. Cut pastry into 10cm circles. Spoon a small amount of vegetable mix onto one half of the circle. Fold over and seal edges with a little water. Press fork around edges to seal.
4. Fry gently in oil until golden brown. Drain on absorbent paper.
5. Serve immediately, on a bed of rocket dressed with balsamic vinaigrette, accompanied by cucumber raita or relish.

### If you are sick...

All timesheets must be submitted to Quay by close of business on Fridays. Timesheets will also be accepted until 11am on Mondays. For candidates whose timesheets are received after 11am on Mondays, your pay will be delayed until the following week.
