RECIPE FOR JULY

HEINZ Big Red Chocolate Cake

Makes 1 cake

HEINZ Big Red Soup proves it's versatility once again!



Ingredients

- 2 1/4 cups Self Raising Flour
- 1/3 Cup Cocoa
- 1 tbsp Bicarbonate of Soda
- 1 1/2 tsp of Cinnamon
- 1 tbsp ground ginger
- 1 1/3 cup Castor Sugar
- 1 x 420g HEINZ Big Red Condensed Tomato Soup
- 2 eggs lightly beaten
- 125g butter melted
- 1/4 cup water

Directions

1. Sift dry ingredients into a large bowl.
2. Add wet ingredients, mix to combine. Using electric beaters, beat on high speed for three minutes. Pour into a greased and lined 23cm round cake pan.
3. Bake in a preheated oven to 180°C for 45-50 minutes, or until a skewer inserted into the centre of the cake comes out clean.
4. Leave in pan for 10 minutes before removing to a wire rack to cool completely. Top with a chocolate frosting and serve garnished with chocolate shavings and strawberries.
