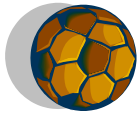
Georgia Mayo (City Office)

Golden Indian Pilaf

Serves 4

A pilaf is an Indian 'one pan' rice dish made with basmatic rice. An easy to prepare dish with an Indian twist.



Ingredients

- 1 onion, finely chopped
- 2 tsp minced garlic
- 2 tsp minced ginger
- 2-3 tsp curry paste (or 1-2 tsps curry powder)
- 2 cups Basmatic rice
- 1 red capsicum and/or 2 celery stalks, diced
- 3 cups chicken stock
- 1-2 x 85g pouch Greenseas Tuna with Zesty Lime and Black Pepper dressing
- 3 hard boiled eggs, quartered
- Fresh coriander



Method

1. In a lidded saucepan, cook the onion, garlic and ginger in a dash of oil until softened
2. Add the curry paste (or powder), Basmatic rice and vegetables and cook and extra minute
3. Stir in the stock, cover, lower the heat and simmer for 12 minutes. Remove from the heat and stand for a further 2 minutes before fluffing the rice with a fork.
4. Lightly stir in the Greenseas Tuna with Zesty Lime and Black Pepper Dressing, eggs and coriander if using. Serve hot.
