RECIPE FOR JUNE

Pumpkin Soup & Tuna Melts

Serves 2

Preparation Time: 10 minutes

Cooking Time: 10 minutes

Ingredients

Focaccia for 2 people
1-2 tbsp chopped fresh or dried parsley or basil
1 cup grated mozzarella cheese
1 - 150g pouch GREENSEAS Oven Dried Tomato & Basil Tuna

1 finely diced red pepper or tomato

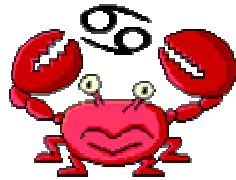
Method

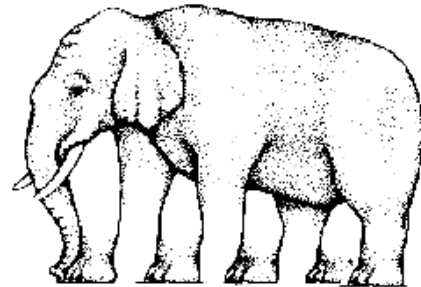
