## RECIPE FOR JUNE

### Tuna and Corn Frittata

Serves 6

Love an omelet? Then you will love this tasty twist to the traditional omelet.



**Preparation Time:** 10minutes

**Cooking Time:** 30 minutes

#### Ingredients

1tbsp butter  
2 cooked potatoes diced  
4 spring onions finely chopped  
1 425g can Greenseas Tuna in Springwater drained  
6 eggs  
2 cups of grated cheese  
1 425g can creamed corn  
Salt and Pepper

#### Method

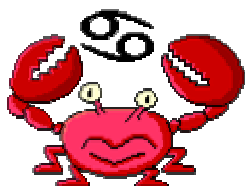
1. Heat butter in a large frying pan. Add potatoes and spring onions and cook for 4 minutes.
2. Combine all remaining ingredients and pour over potatoes. Cook over a medium heat for 15 minutes.
3. Finish cooking under the grill. Frittata is cooked when the surface is golden and is firm to the touch.
