RECIPE FOR MAY

HEINZ Chilli Bean Nachos

Serves 2

Toasted corn chips smothered with melted cheese and topped with a baked bean filled roast capsicum, guacamole, and sour cream.



- 1 x 420g can HEINZ Sweet Chilli Beans
- 1/4 tbsp paprika
- 1/4 tbsp cumin
- 1/2 tbsp chopped coriander
- 1/2 brown onion, finely diced
- 1 red capsicum, cleaned and de-seeded
- corn chips, shredded tasty cheese, guacamole and sour cream, for serving

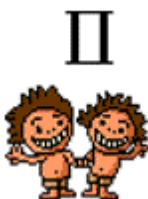
Method

1. Mix above ingredients, heat and stuff into red capsicum shell.
2. Roast stuffed capsicums in a moderate oven (180°C) until capsicum is soft.
3. Arrange corn chips and shredded cheese, and place in moderate oven until cheese is melted.
4. Top with stuffed capsicum, guacamole and sour cream. As dish is served, break capsicum skin and let the chilli bean mix flow over nachos.
