Minestrone Soup

Serves 4

Looking for all the goodness of a traditional Minestrone Soup for those cold winter nights? Try this quick recipe.



Ingredients

1 tbsp Olive Oil
1 brown onion, finely diced
1 clove garlic, finely crushed
1 400g can diced tomatoes
1/2 Cup short pasta (macaroni, spiral or risoni)
1 1/2 litres vegetable stock (or water and stock powder)
1 x 400g can chickpeas or red kidney beans, drained
1 x 450g packet Steam Fresh Vegetables (found in frozen food section of supermarket).
Chopped fresh parsley for garnish
Shredded Parmesan cheese, for garnish

Method

1. Heat oil in large saucepan and cook onion and garlic over a low heat for 2-3 minutes, or until softened.
2. Add tomatoes, pasta and vegetable stock, bring to the boil, reduce heat and simmer for 10 minutes.
3. Add chickpeas, and Steam Fresh Vegetables, cook for a further 2 minutes. Service topped with parsley and Parmesan.
