RECIPE FOR SEPTEMBER

Thai Chicken Curry

Serves 4

HEINZ Thai Green Curry Soup makes this classic Thai dish so easy to prepare!



Ingredients

- 2 tbsp oil
- 1 onion, cut into wedges
- 1 red chilli, deseeded and chopped
- 500g skinless chicken breast fillets, cut into strips
- 1 x 535g can HEINZ Thai Green Curry Soup
- 1/2 - 1 cup water
- 2 zucchini, sliced (or 100g snow peas or green beans, sliced)
- 1-2 tbsps fresh coriander

Method

1. Heat ½ the oil in a frying pan or wok. Brown the onion for 2-3 minutes.
2. Add the chicken and toss in the remaining oil until lightly browned.
3. Add the HEINZ Thai Green Curry Soup and water. Lower the heat, stir, cover and simmer for 10-15 minutes, or until the chicken is tender. Stir in the vegetables in the last 5 minutes.
4. Garnish with fresh coriander. Serve with steamed rice.
